

ISBT128 Implementation Plan

- 1. Determine if ICCBBA Registration is required?**
Criteria for Registration:
 - **All blood collection centers whether free standing or within a hospital must register because their identification number will become an integral part of the unit identification on the label.**
 - **Transfusion services that do not collect blood but only transfuse blood products must register if they apply ISBT128 labels. This applies to facilities that pool, aliquot or modify products and label them with ISBT128 bar codes.**
